Printing out all the workbooks seems expensive- how much does that end up costing?

Based on 10 students, the cost should be around the cost of one printer ink cartridge plus notebooks for each student. Of course, this cost is less if you decide to use only black ink. Another option is to email a copy of the book to each student and have them bring an electronic device for viewing it to class.

I have no idea about how much to charge for the camps- what is the average price?

It wholly depends on the area where you are. Some areas can command \$249 for the classes. You will need to do a little research on the median income and other demographics in your area and price your camps accordingly. Average is \$175-\$275.

I don't know how to promote my camps. Can you give some ideas about that?

I have many, many ideas on places and methods by which to promote your camps how to get free advertising and places to distribute or display your flyers- this is included in the cost of the curriculum. I will share all my ideas and insights with you.

I don't have any experience teaching- I am not sure if I can be effective.

You do not need any experience teaching, but you do need to feel comfortable in front of groups. Each of my teacher's manuals of my curricula are so comprehensive, you will not need anything more than the passion to spread the word about manners to be an effective and inspiring teacher.

I don't have much experience with cooking- do I need to in order to teach the cooking class?

You absolutely must know how to cook to teach this class. But the curriculum is so intensive, if you use it for instructing yourself, you will be able to teach the class after you do all the work in it!

How much does it cost to teach these classes after I purchase the curriculum?

The manners classes usually cost me about \$100 total or more if I decide to provide prizes for the children. I usually only do this for the younger kids. The cooking class is obviously more expensive to initiate, but this cost is

absorbed in the tuition cost. The students will be cooking chickens, shrimp, vegetables, etc. each day and this can get costly. I usually average about \$150 for the food and about \$50 for the printing of the workbooks.

How many students can I expect to teach in one class?

You will want no more than 10 for the manners classes and no more than 8 for the cooking class.

What kinds of supplies do I need for the manners and cooking classes?

For the manners classes, you will need a supply of food magazines that you can allow the children to cut up. You will also need child scissors for each student and a glue stick for each. Additionally, you will need to buy a gift (to be used in class- not to take home) for each student. These will be offered to demonstrate appropriate reactions for receiving gifts. For the cooking class, you will need considerably more items. There is a list included in the cooking packet of information of all the items you need for your kit. You will have many of these items already in your kitchen, but it is likely that you will need to purchase additional items. Everything you need is available at the local Supercenter and none of the items need to be expensive to use in this class.
